In celebration of its 70th anniversary, Montego Bay's iconic plantation resort <code>Half Moon</code>, part of the Salamander Collection, is unveiling a transformation of its Rose Hall Villas. The 19 luxury villas will be reimagined in collaboration with design firm Atelier-Vidal. Located at the eastern end of Half Moon's two miles of shorefront, the Villas at Half Moon offer an independent resort experience catered to families and groups, complete with a personal chef, housekeeper and butler. In celebration of its 50th anniversary, **Rockhouse Hotel** owner Paul Salmon and his team are creating a coffee table book, *Rockhouse: The Book*, that showcases photography and stories of the Negril property from the last half-century. The book will be available for purchase online and in select retailers in New York and Negril. Opened in 1974, the hotel was originally designed by Don Erickson and Dennis Stephens, who met while working for Frank Lloyd Wright in Chicago. Early guests of the property included the likes of Bob Marley and the Rolling Stones. Fifty years later, Rockhouse has been renovated and expanded and now sits on 8 acres with three restaurants, an award-winning spa, a cliff-edge horizon pool and an onsite farm and hydroponic greenhouse where most of the restaurant's produce is grown. *rockhouse.com*
